1. Could you please let us know whether there is a list of prequalified/preapproved General Contractors for it, or if it's open to anyone who attends the mandatory site meet? And as a follow-up question, is there a list of prequalified/pre-approved Mechanical / Electrical subcontractors for it?

7. For the micro piles, are the uplift load cases available? This will impact how we can design the micro piles.

Response: There is no net uplift at the piles.

8. Can helical piles be considered here in lieu of the micro piles as shown? (based on the loadings, this is doable with helical piles)

Response: It is anticipated that obstructions will be encountered when drilling piles due to abandoned foundations from the original Edith

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Cavel building that was previously demolished. For this reason micro piles are recommended, since they can be cored through obstructions.

9. Is there any load testing required for the piles scope of work?

Response: Yes, refer to specification section 31 63 33 Drilled Micropiles.

10. Is there any access limitation/restrictions for equipment for the pile scope of work?

Response: There are no restrictions imposed by the Owner. Contractor to visit site and assess potential limitations.

11. Please confirm the pile count of 36 total.

Response: There are 34 piles total.
