I. QUESTIONS

Q1 – Please advise material for interior windows indicated as “ZZ” New Office Glass-Wall Partitions.

A1 – 12MM Laminated Tempered Glass with structural silicone joints. Please see Drawing A5109 (new).

Q2 – Please advise location for the following items not found. (Anti-ligature Grab Bars, Double Soap Dispenser and Waste Receptacles.

A2 – Anti-ligature grab bars are to be used through out wherever washrooms call for grab bars. The only exception is the 5th floor washrooms

Q3 – There are Shower Rods shown in rooms 008 and 404, please provide specification if part of tender.

A3 – 4.C/S 1075P breakaway carrier with C/S Group curtains. Shower shield pattern with mesh above (contact JonMorris@c-sgroup.com).

Q4 – Please advise if the Handrail shown in corridors on floors 2 and 4 are the same as those specified in section 05 50 00 (2.1.10) If not, please provide specifications.

A4 – All corridor handrails should be anti-ligature Acrovyn Handrails (HRB-35N) from Construction Specialties Inc. with Driftwood finish and Suede texture.

Q5 – Please advise location of Entrance Mats.

A5 – Removed from scope - not required.

Q6 – Refer to the revised drawings A2423, A2443, A2463.
