2.3.2 or failing to furnish a fifty percent (50%) Performance Bond and (50%) Labour and Material Payment Bond within ten (10) days of award date;

2.3.3 or failing to furnish the required Insurance Policies within ten (10) days of award date.

The Bid Bond may be called upon by the Owner to compensate it for any damages it may have suffered as a result of the Bidder's failure.

2.4 I/We agree to comply with the requirements of the Contract Documents, as amended, with respect to Bonds and Insurance. In the event of our Bid not being accepted within sixty (60) days of the time

stated for the closing of receipt of Bids, the Bid Bond will be returned to us forthwith (by electronic means) unless a satisfactory arrangement is made with us covering its retention for a further stated period.

3.0 ALTERNATIVE PRICES

- 5.2 Wage Rates shall include all payroll costs, employee benefits, all agreed local union benefits, payroll burden, including overhead and profit, and present the actual cost to the Owner for Subcontractor labour and for the Contractor's "Own Forces" labour.
- 5.3 Wage Rates for Subcontractor labour shall be as actually quoted and documented by the Subcontractor who is named in the proposed list of Subcontractors and Suppliers.
- 5.4 The Wage Rates for the Contract shall be for either an addition to (extra) or a deduction from (credit) the Contract Price not covered by Unit Prices for the duration of the Contract as follows.
