Please refer to the above Request for Tender document in your possession and be advised of the following:

I. REVISIONS

R1. Revised Submission Deadline

- i. The Submission Deadline Date of this solicitation has been extended to September 8, 2026. The question period will end August 28, 2026.

R2. Revised Part 1 – Section 2, Subsection 2.1.1.1. - Stage 3:

A 10% evaluation advantage will be applied to the Bid with the highest proportion of Ontario-Made Goods and Ontario Services and Canadian-Made Goods and Canadian Services in its Domestic Supply Chain Plan. The evaluation of the Domestic Supply Chain Plan prioritizes Ontario-Made Goods and Ontario Services, followed by Canadian-Made Goods and Canadian Services ("Domestic Content").

To determine which bid will receive an evaluation advantage, the following formula will apply:

$$\text{Domestic Content \%} = \left(\frac{A + A + B}{\text{Bid Price}} \right) \times 100$$

Where:

A = Value of Ontario-Made Goods and Ontario Services

B = Value of Canadian-Made Goods and Canadian Services

Bid Price = Total submitted Bid Price

Description: The value of Ontario-Made Goods and Ontario Services is counted twice for evaluation purposes. The value of Canadian-Made Goods and Canadian Services is counted once. The combined value is divided by the Bid Price and converted to a percentage.

The 10% evaluation advantage is a notional 10% increase in the total score. The 10% increase in score is applied solely for evaluation and ranking purposes, including determining the Bid with the highest proportion of Domestic Content, and does not alter the Supplier's submitted Bid price or the final awarded Contract price.

In the event that two (2) or more Bids have the identical total proportion of Domestic Content, the 10% evaluation advantage will be given to the score of all such Bids.

R3. Revised Part 4 – Form E Domestic Supply Chain Plan has been revised to provide additional simplification to complete the Domestic Supply Chain Plan Form, including:

- i. Expanded instructions and clarifications regarding Ontario Major Goods & Services vs Canadian Major Goods & Services, including an example of duplicate entries.
- ii. Locked and pre-filled fields for editing by suppliers to reduce non-compliance by leaving blank fields.
- iii. Clarification of evaluation method and maximum Domestic Content percentage.
- iv. Guidelines regarding how the City will handle conflicting or unclear values, and discrepancies and mathematical errors.

The revised **Part 4 – Form E Domestic Supply Chain Plan** is attached to this Addendum and replaces the version previously issued with the Request for Tender document.

Suppliers must use the revised Part 4 - Form E Domestic Supply Chain Plan when preparing and submitting their Bid.
